She distributed silk poppies to her peers and campaigned to have it adopted as an official symbol of remembrance by the American Legion. At the 1920 convention the Legion supported Michael's proposal.

Prior to departure you will receive a copy of their Specific License and a Letter of Authorization which legalizes your travel to Cuba.
